



Rules for the cemetery grounds

- All live plants must be in a pot in an elevated urn stand. The urn stand must be positioned adjacent to the gravestone.
- Fresh cut flowers must be displayed in a recessed non-glass receptacle near the gravestone.
- No shepherd's hooks are permitted.
- Do not leave potted plants sitting on the ground or gravestone.
- All plants and pots must be removed by October 15th for winter storage.
- The cemetery does not generally permit artificial decorations, including plastic or silk flowers, styrofoam crosses, balloons, stuffed animals, non-US flags, pinwheels, etc. These types of decorations can only be displayed from Mother's Day through the 4th of July.
- All-natural wreaths and greens are allowed from November 15st to March 15th, as the weather permits.

****All** flowers and memorabilia deemed unsightly, unsafe or inappropriate may be removed at the discretion of the cemetery management.
